Beta definition:

Beta provides a measure of a stock or fund's volatility relative to the market. The market is often defined by a certain benchmark, index or market average. The market's beta is 1. If a stock or fund is more volatile than the market, its beta will be higher than 1. If it is less volatile, the beta will be below 1. An investment that has a beta of 1.25 is believed to be more volatile than its market benchmark. For example, if the benchmark dropped 1 percent, then an investment with a beta of 1.25 is predicted to drop 1.25 percent.
